I never dreamed of how rewarding working on this ride could be! Two years ago when the ride was 'born' it seemed as though we were standing at the bottom of a mountain facing an impossible climb. Frankly, it just looked like a lot of that four letter word... WORK! Well, with the help of many friends, a lot of volunteers, and members of two of the charities we support (Project Healing Waters Fly Fishing and Fan Across America) we persevered and were lucky enough to cover 'first-year' expenses with about \$2,700.00 left over for distribution. Frankly, I was elated with the start we had. © Guess what? That little four letter word 'WORK' kind of disappeared among the smiles of our riders, sponsors, and volunteers as we concluded our day last February 2016. So, guess what? We said, "Let's do it again" and we did.

Last Saturday, 2/25/2017, marked the conclusion of our second annual "Hooked on Healing Veterans" ride. Much less 'WORK' this year and a lot more 'REWARD'. © Ridership was up over 30%. Over the course of two annual rides we have collectively ridden over 23,500 miles incident free! That is remarkable and a true testament to the safety consciousness and preparedness of our riders! Some FUN STUFF from the day included: two riding groups showed up unannounced with large donations; this is the first year for our HONOR CLUB, a method for riders, volunteers, and friends of the ride of all kinds to collect pledges for the ride throughout the year. Stan Kaufman was the top pledge-getter with \$2,840.00 submitted on the 25th; our new Scavenger Hunt was really well received... the winning roll of the dice good enough to collect the \$150.00 cash prize; 50-50 Draw earned one lucky rider \$100.00 which he promptly turned back over to the Ride; © Liberty Mutual Insurance, a sponsor of our ride for two years donated three one week grocery certificates (\$100.00) to three lucky riders; over \$7,000.00 in raffle items and door prizes were fought over for hours (©) and they all disappeared in the flash of an eye at 5:30pm! Mike Dawes of the M.C. of Sun Lakes won the \$150.00 Cow Pie Bingo; and finally... we expect when the 'counting' is all done we will be able to distribute almost \$7,000.00 to our veteran community. "WORK" is now beginning to feel like "WONDER"!

Thanks to everyone who was involved: riders, volunteers, sponsors, individual donors, and the many of you who just keep encouraging us through the months of planning and execution. You are appreciated!
